

HOSTING A VISITOR FROM A NON-EXEMPT STATE?

If you are hosting someone in your home coming from a non-exempt state or another country, they must do one of the following:

- **Test off-campus upon arrival** in Maine and quarantine until a negative test result
- **Test within 72 hours** of arrival in Maine and provide a negative test result
- **Quarantine** for 14 days

Visiting persons from a non-exempt state should **limit contact** with the host family, **wear a mask**, and **wipe down** areas touched until the 14-day quarantine is over **or** a negative test result has been received.

The **faculty/staff/student** host does not need to quarantine in the absence of a negative test from the visitor. They will be allowed to come to campus.

Exempt states are **ME/NH/VT**
